A BRIEF HISTORY OF SONADA DEGREE COLLEGE:

Sonada is a distortion of Lepcha word '*Sanada*'. '*Sana*' in Lepcha means bear and '*daa*' means 'den'. Hence, Sonada refers to the den of bear. The College is situated in Sonada, Darjeeling less than 1 KM from Sonada Railway Station. Sonada Degree College is a co-educational degree college established in the year 1985. It is a Government established college under the pay packet system and the other financial assistance from the Government of West Bengal. The college campus is spread over approximately 2.66 acres of land in an ideal natural environment and very congenial atmosphere for study, sports and other curricular activities. The college has a permanent affiliation with the University of North Bengal. The University Grants Commission (U.G.C) Govt. of India, New Delhi has enlisted this college under section 2(f) and 12 (B) of the UGC Act 1956. Thus this college is eligible to receive financial and other assistance from the UGC, ICSSER, CSI, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India and other Central Govt. organisation in addition to the Govt. of West Bengal. The College imparts higher education leading for the award of Bachelor Degree in both Honours General (Programme) and course under the University of North Bengal. The permanent faculty members of the college are recruited only on the recommendation of the College Service Commission (CSC) Govt. of West Bengal for the number of teaching posts actually sanctioned by the Department of Higher Education and Directorate of Public Instruction.

- 10) Strive towards excellence in all spheres of individuals and collective actively so that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement.
- 11) Provide opportunities for education to his child or ward between age of Six and Fourteen.

COLLEGE RULES AND REGULATIONS:

12. If a student remain absent in five consecutive classes in a subject, he/she shall not be allowed to attend the class in the same subject without the permission of the principal.
